Rolland Fiddle Camp offers a wonderful week of “fiddle immersion” with great players and master teachers in a beautiful small camp setting. Our students range from young to old and from novice players to professional violinists. In our first two years of operation we drew students from all over – Germany, Hawaii, the east coast, the west coast, New Orleans, the southwest and points in-between. We embrace pedagogical principles of Paul Rolland, an ASTA founder and one of the most significant string pedagogues of the 20th century.

We hope this mailing to Colorado string teachers will help “spread the word” about this Colorado musical resource.

This year we are offering tuition waivers to two Colorado string students and their guardians or string teachers. Students interested in applying should do so ASAP.

- 1) **To qualify for consideration**, you must be a Colorado resident enrolled in a string class or taking private lessons, and you must be at least 11 and no more than 23 years of age.
- 2) **Submit the APPLICATION FORM** online. Go to www.peterrolland.com, click on the ROLLAND FIDDLE CAMP link, click on the FEES & REGISTRATION link, scroll down to the APPLICATION FORM, fill out all information, check the “agree” box at the bottom of the “Legal stuff” and finally click the “Submit” button.
- 3) **Tell us about your musical background** and interests. What do you want to learn at camp?

- 4) **Teachers, send a written endorsement** for your student to RFC@peterrolland.com.
- 5) **Scholarship recipients under 18** years of age must be accompanied by an adult guardian or teacher (who will also receive a tuition waiver).
- 6) **The scholarship value is \$335**. Recipients pay only \$385. This goes toward room, board, taxes and a \$35 processing fee.

Teachers, if you have several students who would like to attend camp, please contact me (see below) to discuss a **group discount for you and your students**.

This is by nature a small camp. Students receive lots of individual attention and study in small classes and have opportunities for one-on-one interaction with teachers. Jamming, camp folk orchestra, concerts and square dancing, and the very fine facility make for a relaxed environment and a great sense of camaraderie among students.
